 death we were never divorced. I can
 prove this by Frank and Alice Brooks of Hager-
 stown Md. and by my father Alexander Banks
 of this city. I have not remarried since
 Seldin's death nor lived with any man
 as his wife. I have heard Seldin say
 that he incurred his hernia of right side
 while in the army, I do not recollect as to
 when or where it occurred. He said that
 he slipped and fell some thing going way
 and that he remarked to Perry and Robert-
 Moxley that he was captured. I do not
 recollect of hearing him say whether he was
 treated for his capture while in the service.
