

# DECLARATION FOR INVALID PENSION.

ACT OF JUNE 27TH, 1890.

To be executed before a Clerk of a Court of Record or some Officer thereof having custody of its Seal, or a Notary Public, or a Justice of the Peace, whose Official Signature shall be verified by his own Official Seal, if he has one, or by the proper Clerk, under Seal.

STATE OF Maryland, COUNTY OF Washington SS:

On this 10th day of October, A. D. one thousand eight hundred and ninety one personally appeared before me, a Clerk Circuit Court

within and for the county and State aforesaid James Hill aged 59 years, a resident of the City of Hagerstown, county of Washington, State of Maryland, who, being duly sworn according to law,

declares that he is the identical James Hill who was enrolled on the 28th day of August, 1863, in Co. Band - 1st Brigade U.S.C.T. Here state rank, company and regiment in military service or vessel, if in the navy

in the service of the United States in the War of the Rebellion, and served at least ninety days, and was honorably discharged at Brownsville, Texas, on the 20th day of April, 1866

That he is partially unable to earn a support by manual labor by reason of Pain in region of heart and back; and piles Extent disabled Here name the diseases or injuries from which disabled.

That said disabilities are not due to his vicious habits, and are to the best of his knowledge and belief permanent; that he has before applied for pension under application No. 41516; that he is a pensioner under Certificate No. XXXXXXXXXXXX If a pensioner, the certificate number only need be given; if not, give the number of the former application, if one was made

That he makes this declaration for the purpose of being placed on the pension-roll of the United States under the provisions of the act of June 27, 1890.

He hereby appoints, with full power of substitution and revocation, WILLIAM FITCH & CO, of WASHINGTON, D. C., his true and lawful attorneys to prosecute his claim and to receive therefor a fee of Ten Dollars; that his post office address is Hagerstown
