After service my husband ~~my husband~~ was never able to do hard labor. He did odd jobs around town at anything he could get to do but sometimes did farm labor in the country.

While in service my husband wrote to me from Texas saying that he had taken the scurvy and I think he was then sick in his tent.

He wrote to me again and said that he was then able to be about but that he was hardly able to walk. My husband could not write himself so I have not kept the letters he sent to me when he was in the army.

He had a sore mouth and a bad breath when he came home from the army but I do not think he had lost any teeth.

He always had a sore mouth afterwards while he lived and his teeth were loose and "waggy" looking but he did not lose any of them.

He never was surprised to his bed by sickness. He was able to be up and about the house until the time of his death and died while lying on the lounge with his ordinary day clothes on.
