I am very well acquainted with Mrs Mary E Moxley, the claimant in the above named case and have known her well for many years. I remember when she gave birth to her two children named respectively Robert J. Moxley and William Albert Moxley. I was present as a female attendant upon both occasions. There was present with me upon those occasions my grand-mother, Mary Quinn. She is now dead. Robert J. Moxley was born on December 12, 1877, and William Albert Moxley was born on October 8, 1879.

I recall these dates from my own recollection and from the fact that I saw them each recorded in Mrs Moxley's family bible about one year after each birth took place when each was very distinct in my own mind.
