Affiant further states that he has no interest in this claim or its prosecution.

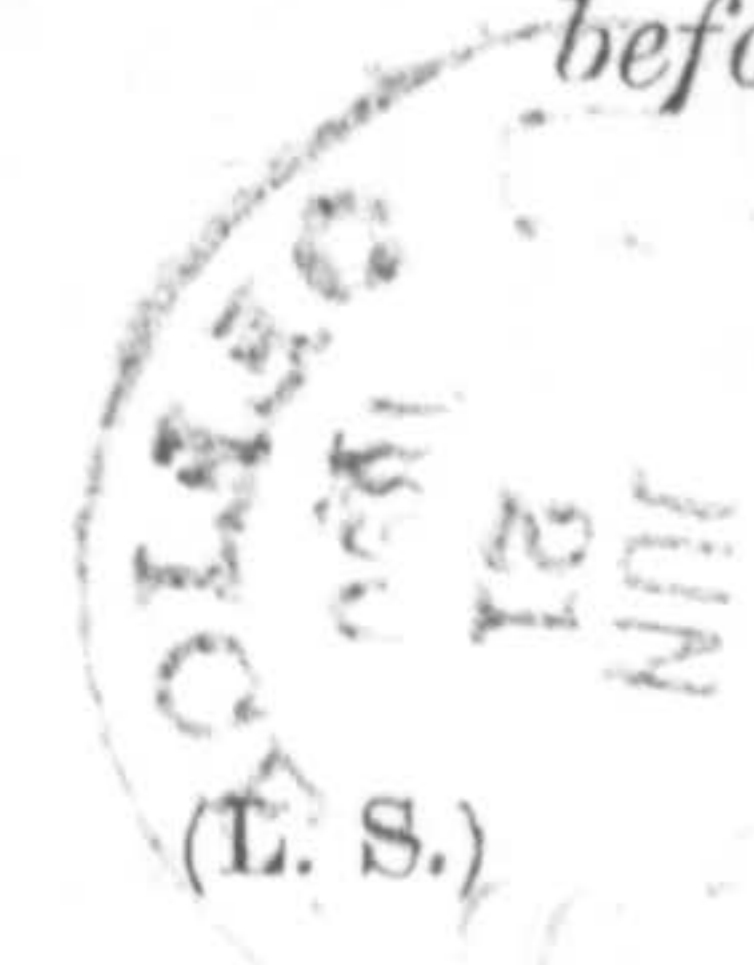
