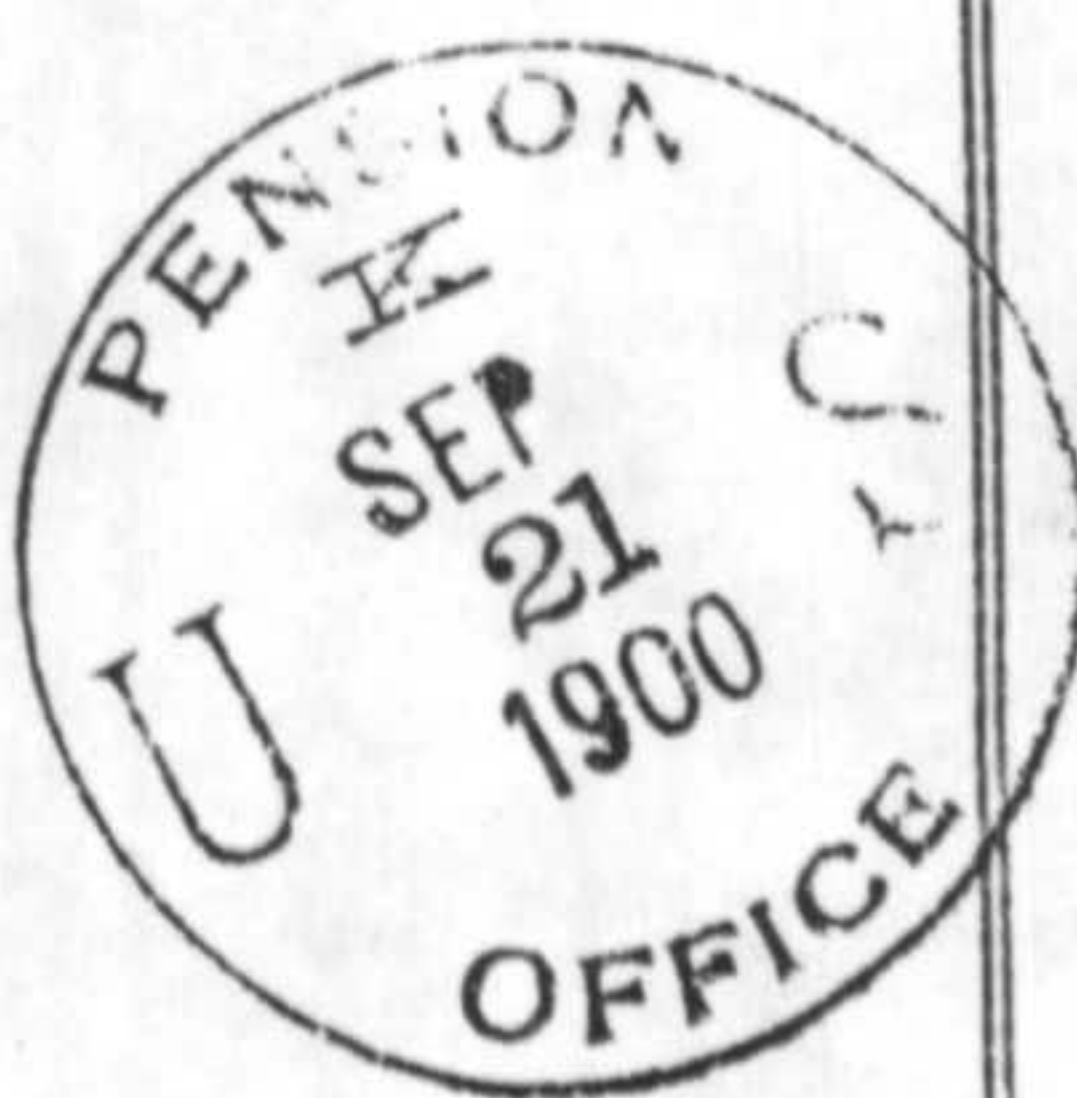
Personally came before me a Justice
