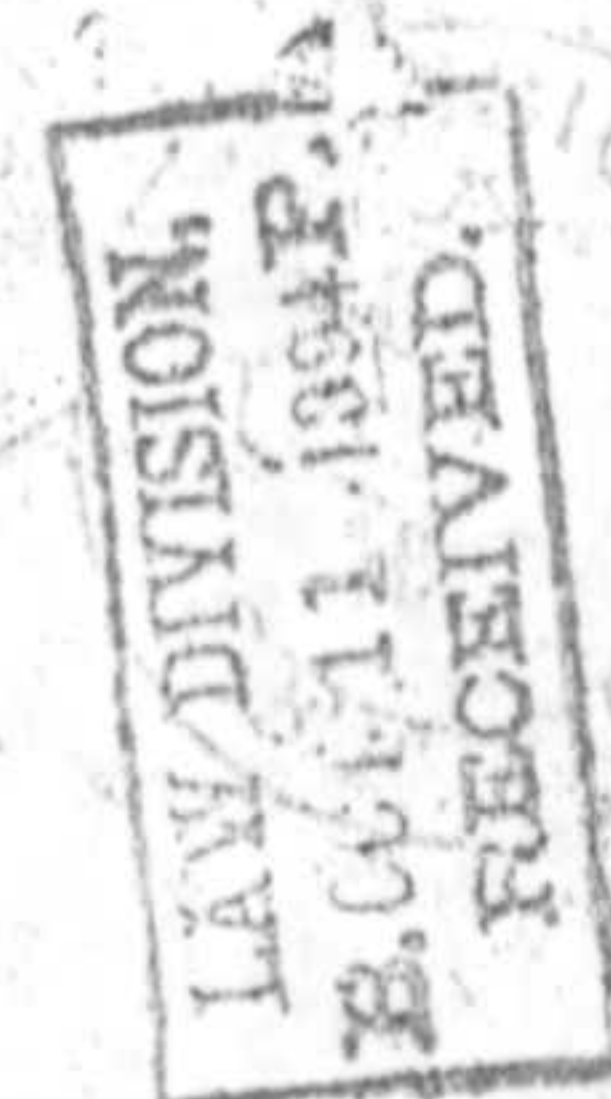

 on the ground that I was not at that time disabled in a
 pensionable degree. -- This was error, as I was then and am now
 greatly incapacitated for manual labor, by reason of these
 disabilities. I ~~have~~ also have catarrh in the head, - and I have
 had pains in the back which I have thought might be due
 to kidney trouble. I am now 64 years old and am suffering from
 debility and the infirmities of age.

My disabilities are not due to vicious habits. I never
 used except as above-stated, and I have not been in the
 military or naval service since I was discharged from the X
