

Declaration for Invalid Pension.

(Act of June 27, 1890.)

To be executed before a Clerk of a Court of Record or a Notary Public or Justice of the Peace *having a Seal*.

State of *Maryland*, County of *Washington*, ss:

On this *16th* day of *July*, A. D. one thousand eight hundred and ninety *one*, personally appeared before me, a *Clerk of Court* in and for the county and State aforesaid, duly authorized to administer oaths, *Perry Mosley* aged *60* years, a resident of the *W. Church St* of *Hagerstown*, county of *Wash*, State of *Md*, who being duly sworn according to law, declares that he is the identical *Perry Mosley* who was enrolled on the *28* day of *Aug*, 1863, in *Mus-Hand 1st Regt. U.S.C. Troop* (Here state rank, company and regiment in military service, or vessel, if in the navy.)

in the war of the Rebellion, and served at least ninety days, and honorably discharged at *Brownsville, Texas* on the *20th* day of *April*, 1866.

That he is unable to earn a support by reason of *right leg broken at the ankle & inflammation with resulting nerve discharge*

That said disabilities are not due to his vicious habits, and are to the best of his knowledge and belief permanent. That he has *not* applied for pension under application No. *_____*. That he is a pensioner under certificate No. *_____*.

(If a pensioner, the certificate number only need be given; if not, give the number of the former application, if one was made.) That he makes this declaration for the purpose of being placed on the pension roll of the U. S. under the provisions of the act of June 27, 1890. He hereby appoints

E. M. Buchanan Washington, D.C. his lawful attorney to prosecute his claim, and agrees to allow *him* a fee of ten dollars. His postoffice address is *Perry Mosley W. Church St. Hagerstown Wash. Ind.*
