I personally came before me a Justice of
the Peace in and for the aforesaid County
and State, Sarah A. Mosley, the claimant,
citizen of Hagerstown, County of Washington,
State of Maryland, well known to me as a
respectable and entitled to credit, she being
duly sworn, declares in relation to aforesaid
case as follows: That she cannot furnish
a verified copy of the public record of her
marriage to the soldier for the reason that

to secure the church record from Pennsylvania,
but has been informed that
no such record exists. That the minister
who performed the ceremony is dead, and
that she cannot secure the testimony
of any witnesses who were present at
the marriage because they are also

record of the marriage. That she has
no income from any source
whatsoever except what she receives
from renting out two rooms, for
which she receives \$2 per month
