

Declaration for Widows Pension

Act of June 27, 1900.

State of Maryland, County of Washington, ss.

On this 19th day of September, A.D.

nineteen hundred, personally appeared

before me, a Justice of the Peace

within and for the County and State

aforesaid, Sarah A. Moxley, aged 55

years, a resident of Hagerstown, County of

Washington, State of Maryland, who, being

duly sworn according to law, declares that

she is the widow of Perry Moxley, who enlisted

under the name of Perry Moxley on the 28thday of August 1863 as 1st Class Mass.

Barracks of First Brigade of United States

Cold Troops Vol., and served at least

twenty days in the late War of the Rebellion

in the service of the United States, and

who was honorably discharged on the 20th

day of April 1866 at Brownsville, Texas, and

died September 7th 1900 - being a pensioner

Certificate No 931, 458. That she was

married under the name of Sarah A. Ryker

to said Perry Moxley on the 21st day of March

1861, by Rev John Rebo, at Green Castle

Pennsylvania - there being no legal

barrier to said marriage. That she

has not re-married since the death

of the said Perry Moxley.

That she is without other means of

support than her daily labor. That her

husband has not been employed in

the military or naval service, or otherwise

than as stated above. That she has

never before this made an application

for a pension. That she makes this
