

DECLARATION FOR INVALID PENSION.

Act of June 27, 1890.

This May be Executed Before Any Person Authorized by Law to Administer Oaths for General Purposes.

duly sworn according to law, declares that he is the identical Robert Morley

who was **ENROLLED** on the 20 day of August, 1863, in

in the war of the rebellion, and served at least
ninety days, and was **HONORABLY DISCHARGED** at Brownsville Texas, on the 20

day of April, 1866. That he is unable to earn a support by

manual labor, by reason of Impaired vision and weakness both eyes

That said disabilities are not due to his vicious habits, and are to the best of his knowledge and belief permanent. That

he has not applied for a pension under application No. ~~That he is a pensioner~~

application, if one was made. If an increase of rate is claimed on account of pensioned disabilities, so state, giving the reason therefor.)

That he made this declaration for the purpose of being placed on the pension roll of the United States under the

of DETROIT, MICH, their successors or legal representatives, his true and lawful attorneys

to prosecute his claim under said law, and agrees to allow them a fee of Ten Dollars.
