

DECLARATION FOR WIDOW'S PENSION.

Act of June 27, 1890.

NOTE.—This can be executed before any officer authorized to administer oaths for general purposes. If such officer uses a seal, certificate of Clerk of Court is not necessary. If no seal is used, then such certificate must be attached.

New Jersey, who, being duly sworn according to law, declares that she is the widow of

Alfred Smith who enlisted under the name of Alfred Smith
at Baggsboro, Md., on the 28th day of August

A. D. 1862 in 39th U.S.C. Troop and was

attached to the Band of 1st Brigade U.S.
C. Troops

and served at least ninety days in the late war of the Rebellion, who was HONORABLY DISCHARGED April
20th 1866, and died February 14th 1889
(The cause of death need not be stated.)

That she was married under the name of Josephine Smith to said
Alfred Smith, on the 20th day of March

1856, by Rev. Mr. Raybolt, at Essexville Pa
there being no legal barrier to such marriage
(If there was a former marriage of claimant or her husband, state it here and how dissolved.)

That she has not remarried since the death of the said Alfred Smith
