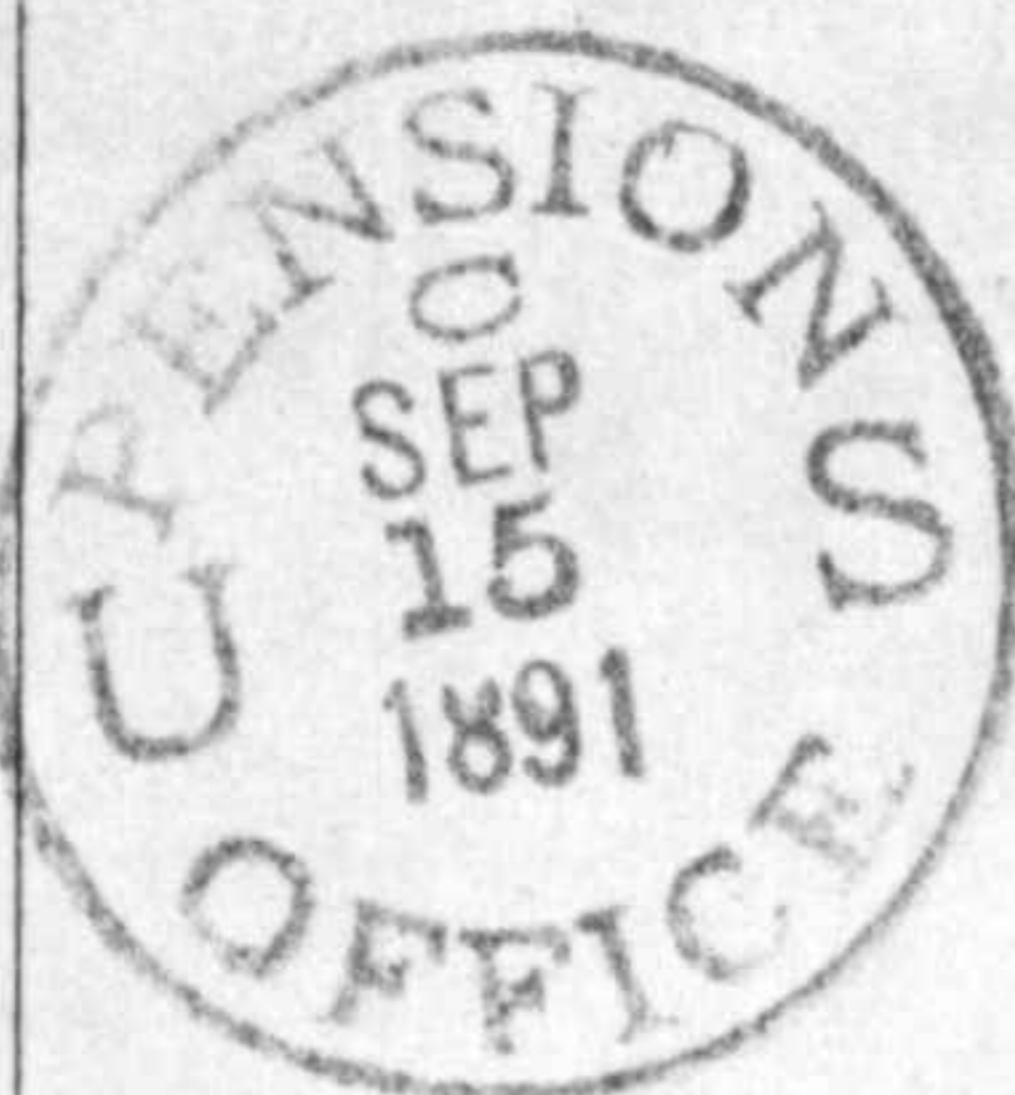

The Act of June 27, 1890, requires in the case of a soldier: An honorable discharge (but the certificate need not be filed unless called for). A minimum service of ninety days. A permanent physical disability not due to vicious habits. (It need not have originated in the service.) The rates under the act are graded from \$6 to \$12, proportioned to the degree of inability to earn a support, and are not affected by the rank held. A pensioner under prior laws may apply under this one, or a pensioner under this one may apply under other laws, but he cannot draw more than one pension for the same period.
