New Hampshire for about three months & then they were assigned to different vessels - He is positive that this claimant is the identical person who served with him under the name of Lasker but states he never knew him under the name of George.

in this he fails to sustain his affidavit Exhibit B. This witness is very old and he impressed me with the fact that his memory failed him on some points. I think he tried to tell the truth.

Thomas Jones Annapolis Md - Depo C - States in his deposition, that he did not know claimant until after the war - that if he served in the same company - Co H. 30 U.S.C. with him, it could not have been at same time that he was in the company.
