



PROOF OF DISABILITY.

NOTE.—This affidavit must be executed by a Commissioned Officer, if possible, but, if not possible to secure such evidence, then two of the soldier's comrades may testify.

ON THIS 2nd day of March A. D. 1890 personally appeared before me, a Justice of the Peace James M. Allen aged 65 years, a resident of Annapolis in the County of Anno Anndar and State of Maryland aged _____ years, a resident of _____

in the County of _____ and State of _____ who being duly sworn according to law, states that he is acquainted with George C. Miller applicant for Invalid Pension, and know the said George C. Miller to be the identical person of that name who enlisted or volunteered as a private in Company D. 30th Regiment of M. & C. I. vols., and who was discharged at Jackson's Hospital on or about _____ day of _____ 186, by reason of _____

That the said George C. Miller while in the line of his duty, at or near Petersburg Va in the State of Virginia did, on or about the 30th day of July, 186, become disabled in the following manner, viz:

by explosion of a shell and Miller was wounded in left hip, whereby he was disabled and sent to Hospital at City Point Va and thence to Alexandria Va, where he was finally discharged.

That the facts stated are personally known to the affiant, by reason of I was Orderly Ser.
