

Application for Increase of Pension.

Act of June 27, 1890.

~~To be executed before the Clerk of some Court of Record, a Notary Public, having a seal, or a Justice of the Peace, whose official character must be certified by a Clerk of a Court of Record.~~

State of Maryland, County of Anne Arundel, ss:

On this 7th day of November, A. D., 1891, personally appeared before me a Justice of the Peace within and for the County aforesaid, George C. Miller, aged 46 years, a resident of Annapolis County of Anne Arundel, State of Md, who being duly sworn, according to law, declares that he is the identical George C. Miller, who was ENROLLED on the 24 day of Feb'y 1864, as a private in Co. "20" of the 30 Regiment of U.S.C. I. Vols. Volunteers in the service of the United States, in the War of the Rebellion; that he is a pensioner of the United States, enrolled at the Washington Pension Agency at the rate of \$6.00 dollars per month, Certificate No. 538,719 by reason of disability from Rheumatism.
State name of disability for which pensioned as it appears on your Certificate.

That he believes himself to be entitled to an increase of pension on account of the following disabilities:

in addition to Rheumatism :- Shell wound of left hip.

He feels that his present rating is not commensurate with the degree of his disability. He therefore files this application for increase of pension, and requests a medical examination by a board of examining surgeons, to whom special instructions may be issued, so that the full extent of his disabilities may be ascertained. That he hereby appoints, with full power of substitution and revocation,

Chas. Donnelly Co. of Washington, D.C. his true and lawful attorney... to prosecute his claim.
