

SOLDIER'S APPLICATION FOR INCREASE OR ADDITIONAL PENSION

Act of June 27, 1890, amended May 9, 1900.

State of Maryland, County of Ann Arundel, ss:

ON THIS 27 day of May A. D., one thousand nine hundred and four personally appeared before me, an officer authorized to administer oaths for general purposes, within and for the County and State aforesaid, George C. Miller AGED 60 years,

who being duly sworn according to law, declares that he is a pensioner of the United States, duly enrolled at the Washington D.C. Pension Agency, at the rate of 6.00 dollars per month, CERTIFICATE No. 53879

That he was enrolled in Co. D 30 Reg't U.S.C. Vols., in the State rank, company and regiment. If the Army or vessel, if in the Navy.

Service of the United States, in the War of the Rebellion, served at least ninety days, and was honorably discharged.

That he never served in the military or naval service of the United States before 23 day 7 February 1864 or after 27 day 7 May 1865

That he believes himself to be entitled to an increase of pension on account of increased disability.

That he is disabled by reason of the following disabilities: Rheumatism
(NOTE.—Here name ALL the diseases or injuries from which disabled and which are not due to vicious habits.)
and results age and resulting in paralysis that he is totally blind and unable to perform any kind of work.

That said disabilities are not due to vicious habits, and are to the best of his knowledge and belief permanent in character and disable him from earning a support by manual labor.

That he makes this application under Act of June 27, 1890 as amended by Act of May 9, 1900, and orders of the Commissioner of Pensions approved by the Secretary of the Interior.

That he desires to be examined by the Board of Surgeons at Baltimore Maryland

He hereby appoints, with full power of substitution and revocation,

his true and lawful attorneys, to prosecute his claim.
