I can only swear to the best of my knowledge that the boys were six years of age in 1880 according to facts gathered and appearance of children and further believe that the statements she has made in regard to the children are correct, I have known W<sup>m</sup> & Mary Smith his widow for several years as well as the boys, believing that the above statement is all that I can
