My dear Mr. Price:

In response to your letter of the 19th instant, asking for information as to the status of the claim for pension of Lavina Bennett, of 319 High Street, Cambridge, Maryland, as widow of Robert Bennett, Co. D, 7 U.S.C. Infantry, I have the honor to advise you that it has been necessary to have a special examination therein to develop certain information necessary to its just adjudication, and the papers have accordingly been placed in the hands of a special examiner of this Bureau, whose district includes Dorchester County, Maryland, and when he reaches the case in its turn on his docket, he will call upon the claimant, and after fully advising her of the purpose and scope of the proposed examination he will take her statement and secure such other evidence as is available and pertinent, and when his report is rendered the claim will receive prompt consideration in this Bureau.
