Act of June 27, 1890,

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DECLARATION FOR INVALID PENSION.

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Under a recent act of Congress this Declaration may be executed before any officer authorized to administer oaths. If such officer has no seal, a certificate of a Clerk of Court is necessary.

State of Maryland County of Allegany ss:
 ON THIS 18 day of July A. D. one thousand eight hundred and ninety
 personally appeared before me, a justice of the peace
 within and for the county and State aforesaid, Robert Dorsey
 aged 48 years, a resident of the Town of Frostburg
 county of Allegany, State of Md. who, being
 duly sworn according to law, declares that he is the identical Robert Dorsey
 who was enrolled on the 16 day of March 1864, in Co. I, 36th Regt.
Ordered Vol. Inf. Here state rank, company and regiment
 in Military service, or vessel, if in the Navy. and served about 6 months in the Infantry when
he was transferred to the Cavalry serving on the ship Lancaster
 ninety days, and was HONORABLY DISCHARGED at Norfolk, Va. on the 18
 day of March 1867, That he is to a great extent unable to earn a support by reason of
graft and kidney trouble
 Here name the disease or injuries from which disabled.

That said disabilities are not due to his vicious habits, and are to the best of his knowledge and belief permanent.

That he has not applied for pension under application No.

That he is a pensioner under Certificate No.
 If a pensioner, the Certificate number only need be given. If not, give the number of the

former application if one was made.

That he makes this declaration for the purpose of being placed on the pension rolls of the United States under the provisions of the Act of June 27, 1890.

He hereby appoints N. W. WILLS & CO., of Washington, D. C., his true and lawful attorneys, and he agrees to allow them the \$10 fee as prescribed by law for prosecuting his claim. That his Post-Office address is
