

Declaration for the Increase of an Invalid Pension.

On this 7 day of Octo. A. D., one thousand eight hundred and ninety

personally appeared before me, the undersigned officer, duly authorized to administer oaths within the County and State aforesaid, Edward Dosham
[Name of Claimant.]

who being duly sworn according to law, declares that he is a pensioner of the United States, (Certificate No. 863,843) enrolled at the Washington Pension Agency at the rate of 8 Dollars per month, by reason of disability from injury to ankle

and Bronchitis incurred in the military service of the United States

That he believes himself to be entitled to, and now claims an INCREASE of pension on account of insufficient rating for said disability, as he believes that the rating now allowed and paid him is absurdly low and wholly disproportionate to the degree of disability and his inability to perform the manual labor of a healthy man as same now exists. And he also alleges that he now suffers from not only increased disability, as to injured ankle + Bronchitis, for

which he is pensioned but having had a stroke of paralysis some ten years. It has made it impossible for him to do any manual labor at all. his left side is disabled almost entirely + his left arm + hand are nearly useless.
