

Declaration for the Increase of an Invalid Pension.

On this 19 day of March A. D., one thousand eight hundred and ninety-nine personally appeared before me, the undersigned officer, duly authorized to administer oaths within the County and State aforesaid, Edward D. Dosham

who being duly sworn according to law declares:

I am a pensioner of the United States, (Certificate No. W) enrolled at the Washington Pension Agency at the rate of 8 Dollars per month, by reason of Crippled ankle

That I now suffer from Lameness of ankle stroke of paralysis

and I desire to be examined by the U. S. Pension Surgeons at Baltimore office

I appoint with full power of substitution and revocation, C. D. PENNEBAKER, of Washington, D. C., my true and lawful attorney to prosecute this claim.
