Regimental Return for September, 1865, reports private "Joseph Cole", present, On daily duty in Ordnance Dept., but does not report private Maddy absent.

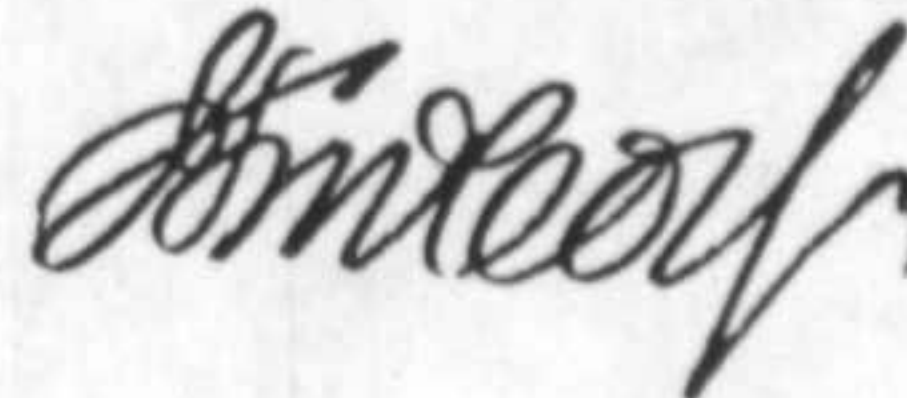
The name Thomas Maddy is not borne on the rolls of that Company.
