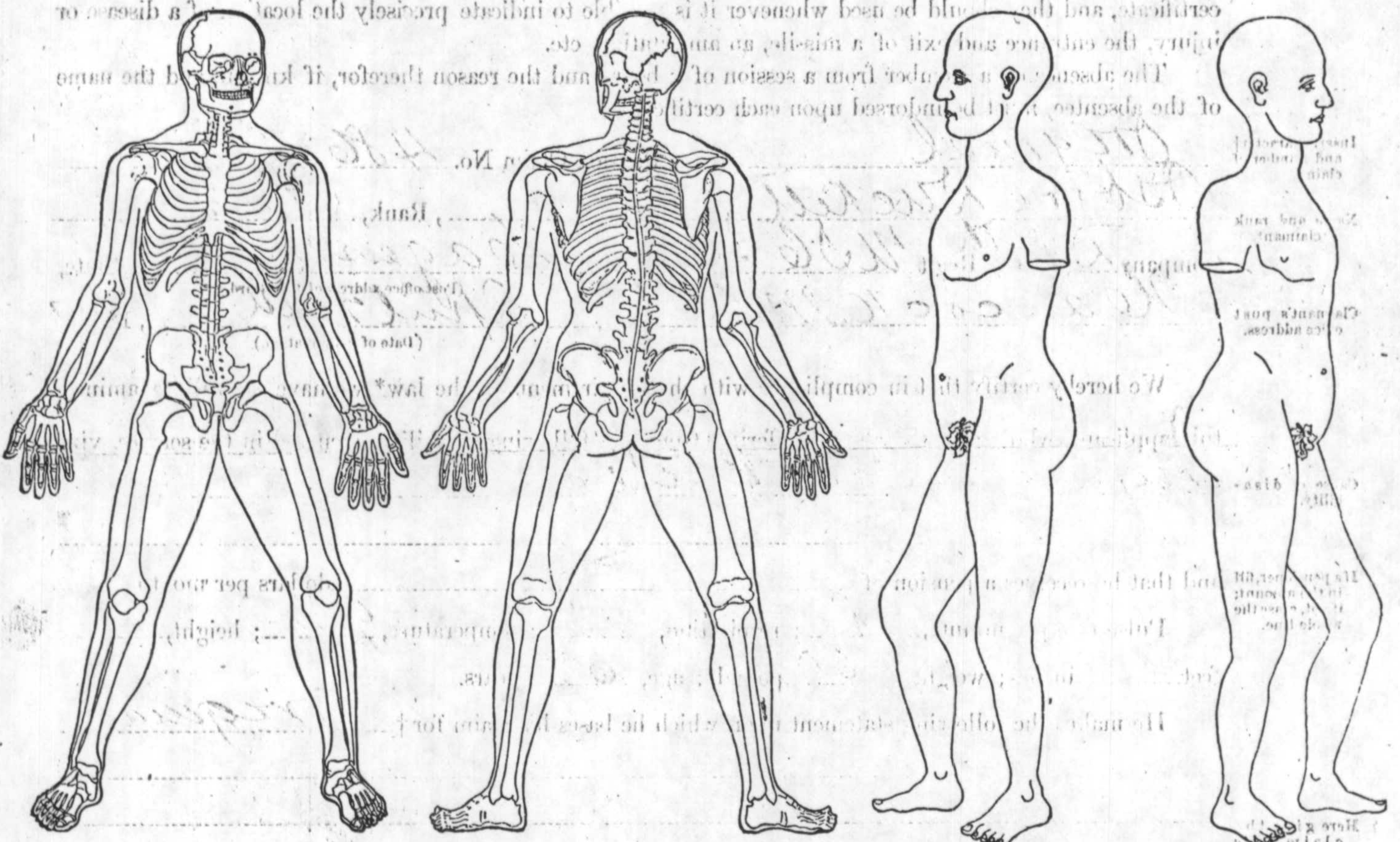




Upon examination we find the following objective conditions:
