The Rev. Richard Lane, who performed the ceremony of marriage between *Daniel Brice*, late of C. D., 30 U.S.C. Inf., and *Martha Brice*, widow of said *Daniel Brice*, and that the date of the marriage was *October 22, 1866*. and that after the death of *The Rev Richard Lane* all of his church records were delivered to his successor and many were lost, among them the record of the aforesaid marriage, but that she was present and witnessed the marriage.

Also on the *14th August, 1916* appeared *Isaac Adams*, age *76*, and made oath in due form of law that he was well acquainted with *Daniel Brice* and *Martha Cromwell*, and that he was present at the marriage ceremony; his present office address is *602 Vane st, Baltimore Md.* and that *Martha Cromwell* was the maiden name of *Martha Brice*, the widow of said *Daniel Brice*. late of C. D., 30 U.S.C. Inf.
