

Declaration for the Increase of an Invalid Pension.

State of Maryland County of Anne Arundel

On this 17th day of October A. D. one thousand eight hundred and ninety one

Personally appeared before me, a Justice of the Peace within and for the county and State aforesaid, Danice Brice aged 46 years, a resident of Annapolis county of Anne Arundel State of Maryland

who, being duly sworn according to law, declares that he is a pensioner of the United States, enrolled at the Washington DC Pension Agency at the rate of 12 dollars per month, Certificate No. 453726 by reason of disability from Phlebotomy and resulting disease of Heart (Here state the name of the disease, wound, or injury for which pensioned, as it appears on your certificate.)

incurred in the military service of the United States while serving as a Private (State your rank.) in Co. D 30 Reg't, USCT Vols. That he believes himself to be entitled to an increase of pension on account of disability resulting from cause aforesaid. He feels that the rate of pension which he now receives is not commensurate with degree of his disability.

That he believes his disability from pensioned cause is equivalent to the loss of a hand or foot, and hereby requests that his rate be increased under the old law, as his pensioned disabilities are of army origin, and he waives pension under Act of June 27, 1890.

He hereby appoints, with full power of substitution and revocation, CHARLES J. DONNELLY & CO., of Washington, D. C., his true and lawful attorneys to prosecute his claim.
