On this 20th day of June A. D. one thousand eight hundred and ~~eighty~~ 90 personally appeared before me, a Justice of Peace within and for the county and State afore-said, Daniel Brice aged 45 years, a resident of Annapolis county of Anne Arundel State of

Md. who, being duly sworn according to law, declares that he is a pensioner of the United States, enrolled at the Washington Pension Agency at the rate of 8.00 dollars per month, Certificate No. 45B726 by reason of disability from Rheumatism and resulting disease of heart (Here state the name of the disease, wound, or injury for which pensioned, as it appears on your certificate)

incurred in the military service of the United States while serving as a Private [State your rank.] in Co. D 30 Reg't. A.C.C. Vols. That he believes himself to be

entitled to an increase of pension on account of disability resulting from cause aforesaid. He feels that the rate of pension which he now receives is not commensurate with degree of his disability.

That his disability is increasing that he is almost
unable to perform any manual labor from an accumulation of Rheumatism
and pain in chest. Small part of the back and
suffering almost constantly with head ache

He hereby appoints with full power of substitution and revocation, Chas. J. Donnelly & Co. CHARLES J. DONNELLY, of Washington, D. C., his true and lawful attorney, to prosecute his claim.
