

Declaration for the Increase of an Invalid Pension.

State of Maryland County of Anne Arundel ss:

On this 24th day of November A. D. one thousand eight hundred and eighty nine personally appeared before me, a Justice of Peace within and for the county and State aforesaid, Daniel Price aged 44 years, a resident of Annapolis county of Anne Arundel State of Md. who, being duly sworn according to law, declares that he is a pensioner of the United States, enrolled at the Washington Pension Agency at the rate of 4 dollars per month, Certificate No. 403.726 by reason of disability from "Rheumatism and resulting disease of heart" (Here state the name of the disease, wound, or injury for which pensioned, as it appears on your certificate.)

incurred in the military service of the United States while serving as a Volunteer [State your rank.] in "D" 30th Reg't. U.S.C. Vols. That he believes himself to be entitled to an increase of pension on account of disability resulting from cause aforesaid. He feels that the rate of pension which he now receives is not commensurate with degree of his disability.

His disability is constantly growing worse resulting disease of left lung; he suffers greatly with rheumatism; therefore he asks a higher rating in accordance with the advanced degree of his disability.
