

ACT OF MAY 11, 1912.

DECLARATION FOR PENSION.

THE PENSION CERTIFICATE SHOULD NOT BE FORWARDED WITH THE APPLICATION.

State of Maryland, County of Anne Arundel, ss:
 On this 24th day of June, A. D. one thousand nine hundred and twelve, personally
 appeared before me, a Notary Public, Daniel Bruce, who, being duly sworn according to law, declares that he is 66 yrs 8 mos.
 years of age, and a resident of Annapolis, county of Anne Arundel,
 State of Maryland; and that he is the identical person who was ENROLLED at Baltimore
 on the 24th day of February, 1864, as a private, in Company 'D'
30th Regiment United States Army,
 (Here state rank, and company and regiment in the Army, or vessels if in the Navy.)
 in the service of the United States, in the Civil war, and was HONORABLY DISCHARGED
 at Roanoke, Virginia, on the 10th day of December, 1865.
 That he also served _____

That he was not employed in the military or naval service of the United States otherwise than as stated above. That his per-
 sonal description at enlistment was as follows: Height, 5 feet 6 inches; complexion, dark; color
 of eyes, dark brown; color of hair, black; that his occupation was blacksmith; that he
 was born October 16th, 1845, at Annapolis, Maryland.
 That he believes himself to be entitled to the \$30 rate of pension on account of the following named disabilities contracted
 in the service, and which now renders him unfit for manual labor, viz: Rheumatism and urinary
disease of heart

That he is a pensioner under certificate No. 4537216. That he has _____ applied for pension under original
 No. _____
 That he makes this declaration for the purpose of being placed on the pension roll of the United States under the provisions
 of the act of May 11, 1912.

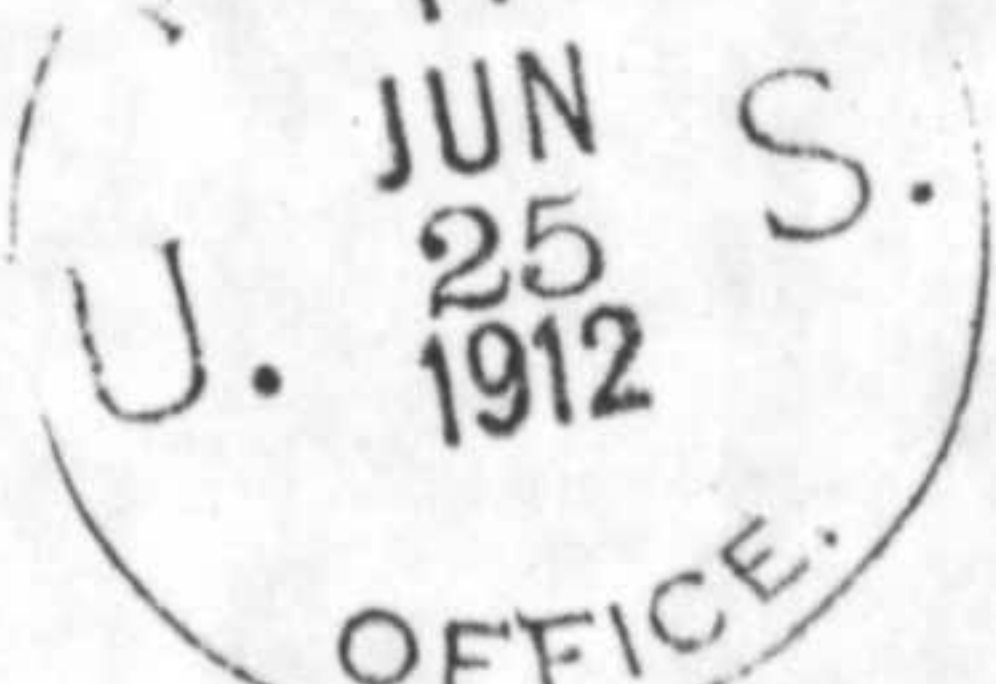
He hereby appoints, with full power of substitution, MILO B. STEVENS & CO., of Washington D.C.,
