Names of disabilities.

Rheumatism and resulting disease of heart, for which pensioned at \$17.00. Alleges kidney trouble, disease of eyes and stomach, and nervous prostration in addition. He receives a pension of Seventeen dollars per month.

Here give the claimant's statement (as briefly and as compactly as possible) in regard to the date of origin and cause of his disabilities and the manner in which they affect him.

He makes the following statement in regard to the origin of his disabilities and date when first discovered by him: "Contracted my disabilities while in the army. Cannot do any work."

Birthplace, Annapolis, Md.; age, 60 years; height, 5-3/4; weight, 180 pounds; complexion, Brown; color of eyes, Dark; color of hair, Black & Gray; occupation, None; permanent marks and scars other than those described below, Scar on left knee

We hereby certify that upon examination we find the following objective conditions:

Pulse rate, 84, 90, 100; respiration, 21, 26, 36; temperature, 98; [Sitting, standing, after exercise.] [Sitting, standing, after exercise.]

Rheumatism: He complains of severe soreness in all muscles upon manipulation. He has no deformity or limitation of motion of joints. He stoops over and recovers himself with evident pain and difficulty, owing to soreness in the muscles of the back and thighs. His movements indicate that he suffers with muscular rheumatism.

Muscular Rheumatism, Rating 8/18.

Facts within the knowledge of the Board, or any member thereof, relative to the cause of any disability found should be stated.

Heart---Apex impulse apparent by palpation in fifth inter-space, one inch to right of left nipple. Cardiac dullness extends from apex, to middle of sternum and to fourth left chondrocostal articulation. Action is regular. No valvular lesion. No hypertrophy or dilatation. No dyspnoea, cyanosis or edema. No rating.

Kidneys: He presents no symptoms whatever of disease of Kidneys. Urine amber. S. G. 1020. Acid. No sugar or albumen.

Eyes: External and internal structures each eye are in normal condition. Vision each eye 20/70. No rating.

Stomach: He has no disease of stomach. All digestive organs are normal in size and function. He has no abdominal soreness. No rating.

Nervous Prostration: He has no impairment of spinal, nervous or mental functions. No vertigo, spasms, convulsions or nausea. No chronic meningitis. No paralysis, local or general. No difficulty in swallowing. Breathing regular. No muscular tremor. Coordination of movements not impaired. No rating.

He has no disease of Lungs. Chest symmetrical; expiration 39, rest 40, inspiration 41.

No other disability found to exist.

no presents no evidence of symptoms of disease or other vicious habits.

His disability is permanent.
