Sir:

In your above-entitled claim for pension under the disability clause of the act of May 11, 1912, there should be filed medical evidence showing whether you were unfit for manual labor by reason of rheumatism and resulting disease of heart, independent of any other disability, on June 25, 1912, the date of filing your application, and have been since that date.

The evidence, which should be sworn to before some officer authorized to administer oaths for general purposes, should embody a full description of the said disabilities, mere conclusions as to your unfitness for manual labor not being sufficient. You should also comply with the requirements indicated in the accompanying regular letter.
