Madam:

In your above-cited claim for pension, there is required a copy of the church record, under seal or oath, showing the date of your marriage to the soldier; or if said marriage is not of record, that fact should be shown by a certificate, under seal or oath, from the custodian of such records, and there should be furnished the affidavit of the person who performed the ceremony, or testimony of witnesses who were present, showing the date thereof. The copy of your marriage license filed May 31, 1916, is not satisfactory evidence to show that the marriage was solemnized.

Witnesses should state their ages, post office addresses, means of knowledge and length of acquaintance.

Do not fail to inscribe upon each piece of evidence filed the soldier's name, service and number of your claim.
