To the Honorable Commissioner of Pension I thought I would write to you to inform you of my condition when I was granted pension under president Cleveland's administration under the rate of \$4.00 a month for Rheumatism, & heart failure. Since then I was increased to \$17.00 a month I have not been able to do a days manual labor on account of my disabilities only to do a little

white washing among my neighbors. Since 1911 I have not been able to earn 5^{cts} a month for work and not able to raise my head at times above my head. Sometimes I can scarcely walk all my support is what I get from the government. To your honor Sir I objected from all secret association in amazolis the doctors turn me down on account of my disabilities. To your honor please do all you can for me in my claim under this new act of Congress age 67 Daniel Brice Company D. 30th Regiment Certificate number 453,726
