Regiment was stationed Aug 5. 64 at Jacksonville Fla. Sept 29-30 In the field Va.

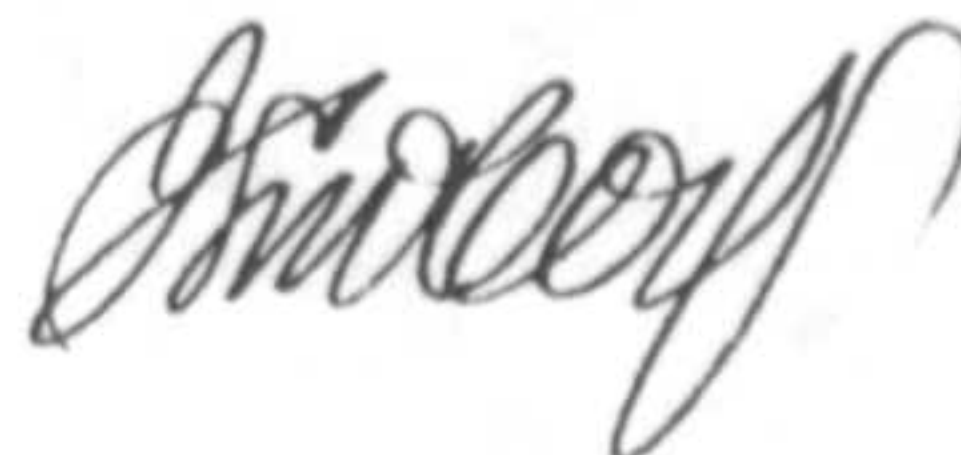
