ACT OF JUNE 27, 1890.

DECLARATION FOR INVALID PENSION.

Under Act of Congress approved July 1, 1890. this application may be executed before a Notary Public, Justice of the Peace, or any Officer authorized to administer oaths.

That he is partially unable to earn a support by reason of Rheumatism lumbago, injury right foot and

That said disabilities are not due to vicious habits, and are to the best of his knowledge and belief permanent. That he has applied for pension under application No.

That he is a pensioner under Certificate No. 490607. That he has never

been employed in the United States military or naval service otherwise than as stated above

(If in the service other than as above stated, state the company, regiment, &c., in which you served, and date of enlistment and discharge. If you rendered no other service write the word "never" after the words "he has.")

That he has not been in the military or naval service of the United States since the day of November 1866
