- 4 David Brooks, and Dr. Phillip Briscoe, Calvert Co., Md., Apr 14, 1919, statement; soldier died Dec 5, buried Dec 7, 1918.
- 5 B.A. Duke, Calvert Co., Md., Apr 14, 1919, copy of record from record of Justice of Peace, showing marriage of Clmt and soldier, May 6, 1880.
- 6 Clerk, Court of Common Pleas, Baltimore, Md., Oct 23, 1919, copy of record of marriage of soldier to Agnes Mason, May 6, 1880.
- 7 May 28, 1919, copy of record of soldiers marriage to Agnes Mason May 6, 1880.
- 8 Jan 10, 1920, statement; no record of marriage of soldier and Annie Moore.
- 9 Claimant, May 28, 1919, marriage certificate of Clmt and soldier, married May 6, 1880.
- 10 Soldier, Aug 16, 1890, marriage circular; married Annie Moore 1880, by Rev. Robt R. Steal; no previous marriage; married May 6.
- 11 Marriage circular; born at St Leonards Creek, Md., ~~Mar~~ no previous marriage; no previous marriage of wife; now living with wife; Filed Mar 25, 1915.
- 12 David Brooks, Oct 30, 1919, conjugal state of soldier;
- 13 David Brooks, and Hezekiah Locks, Island Creek, Md., Feb 26, 1919, statement; conjugal state of soldier.
- 14 David Brooks, and Samuel Parker, Island Creek, Md., Apr 14, 1919, statement; Rev Steele is dead.
- 15 Celia Herrod and Minty Campbell, Island Creek, Md., Nov 6, 1919, statement; Clmts first marriage to soldier; cohabitation;
- 16 David Brooks, and Samuel Parker, Island Creek, Md., July 29, 1919, statement; conjugal condition of soldier.
- 17 Aug 14, 1899, statement; soldier had one prior marriage.
- 18 Oct 9, 1919, statement; Clmt now soldiers widow; soldier married Agnes Mason, separation; she left country.
