

DECLARATION FOR PENSION.

The Pension Certificate should not be forwarded with the application.

State of Maryland County of Calvert ss:

ON THIS 11th day of June A. D. one thousand nine hundred and twelve personally appeared before me, Clara J. Vincent Court within and for the County and State aforesaid, James Wilson, who, being duly sworn according to law,

declares that he is 65 years of age, and a resident of Blount Creek County of Calvert, State of Maryland; and that he is the

identical person who was ENROLLED at Benedict, Charles county, Md under the name of James Wilson, on the 2nd day of October, 1863, as a Private, in Company 76, 7th Regiment U. S. Cold Light (Here state rank, and company and regiment in the Army, or vessels if in the Navy.)

in the service of the United States, in the Civil War, and was **HONORABLY DISCHARGED** at Indianola, Texas, on the 13th day of October, 1865.

That he also served from 186 to 186 in Co. Regt. Vols. (Here give a complete statement of all other services, if any.)

That he was not employed in the military or naval service of the United States otherwise than as stated above. That his personal description at enlistment was as follows: Height, 5 feet 3 inches; complexion, Blk; color of eyes, Blk; color of hair, Blk; that his occupation was Farmer; that he was born 18 at St Leonard Calvert county, Md.

That he has applied for pension under original No. That he makes this declaration for the purpose of being placed on the pension roll of the United States, under the provisions of the Act of May 11, 1912.

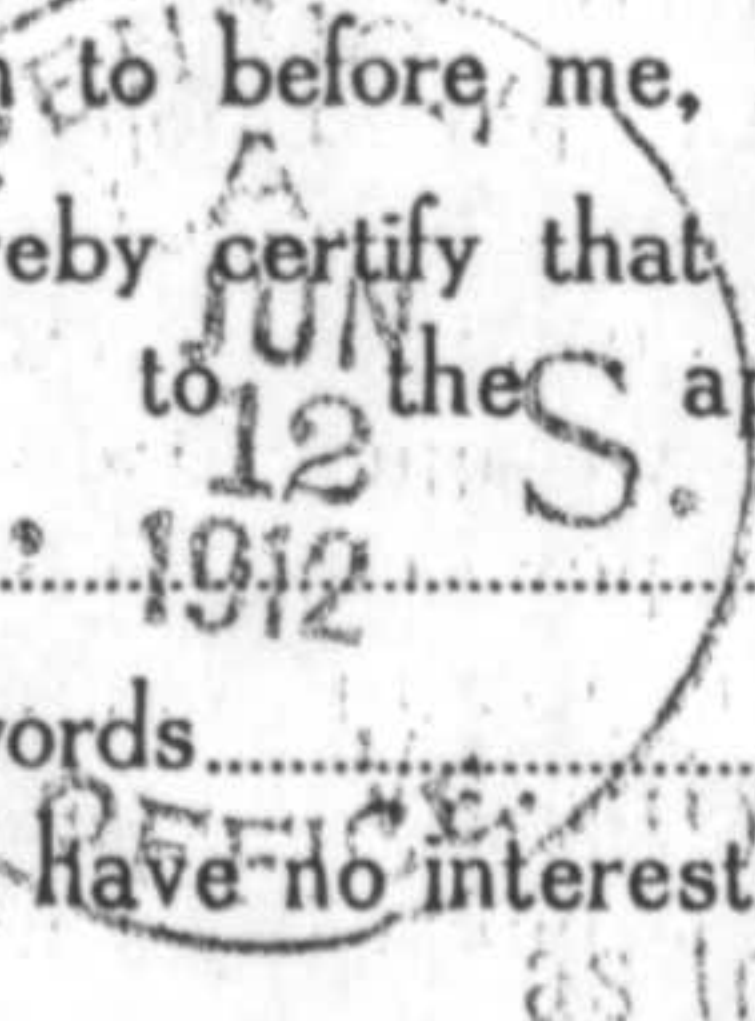
That he hereby appoints **Wm. FLETCHER & CO.**, his attorneys in this case.
