Sir:

In the case above designated, in which an opinion has been requested as to whether the claimant can be accepted as the widow of the soldier, one David Brooks testified before Special Examiner David H. Stovall, June 23, 1921, that he last saw the claimant in the courthouse at Prince Frederick, Maryland, where she was called to testify in a claim she had made to get some of the soldier's property. Before rendering a final opinion on the question at issue, it is desired to know the nature of the claim instituted by her against the soldier's estate, and the outcome of it. The papers are herewith transmitted to you with the request that a special examiner be instructed to obtain the desired information from the records of the court.

Was the claim for a widow's interest in the estate?

Has the claimant been judicially recognized as the widow of the soldier?

When the information indicated shall have been received, please return the papers to this Division for further consideration.
