We hereby certify that in compliance with the requirements of the law we have carefully examined this applicant, who states that he is suffering from the following disability, incurred

in the service, viz: Lumbago: Injury of right foot from burn; and General debility.

He makes the following statement upon which he bases his claim for INCREASE

[Original, increase, restoration, &c.]

Here give the claimant's statement as briefly and as compactly as possible.

Claims increase on the ground that the disability is increasing. Has severe pains across the back with difficulty in stooping. After attempting any hard work is laid up for a couple of days. Had a burn of right foot that causes some pain at times, but he does not make any claim for disability.

Upon examination we find the following objective conditions: Pulse rate, 72 respiration, 18; temperature, N; height, 5 feet 5 inches; weight, 138 pounds; age, 47 years. General physical condition is good.

Here give a full description of the disabilities, in accordance with pars. 5, 6, 51, 52, &c., of Book of Instructions for 1889

Suffers severely with Lumbago: Sensitiveness of muscles in the lumbar regions with pain and stiffness when stooping and when regaining the erect position. Has apparently some difficulty in picking objects from the floor. States that he is unable to lift any weight. There is tenderness about the right hip with pain when walking that extends down the leg.

No evidence whatever of Rheumatism in the joints. We would recommend a rating of eight dollars a month for Musc. Rheumatism as it probably interferes with manual labor as claimed.

Heart, lungs and abdominal organs are in healthy condition. Scar evidently the result of burn, on the outer border of sole of right foot just in line of outer malleolus.

Scar is superficial, 1 1/2 inches in diameter, whitish, non-adherent and causes no disability.

No other disability exists.
