We hereby certify that in compliance with the requirements of the law we have carefully examined this applicant, who states that he is suffering from the following disability, incurred in the service, viz: Gun Shot Wound of Right Foot and Right Side and Effects. Rheumatism and Rupture of Testicles.

Cause of disability.

Here give the claimant's statement as briefly and as compactly as possible.

He makes the following statement upon which he bases his claim for INCREASE [Original, increase, restoration, &c.] Claims that wound of foot causes pain and lameness and at times it swells. Has pain in the right side and back as result of gun shot wound. Suffers with Rheumatism in the back and breast. Has rupture of the left side.

Here give a full description of the disabilities, in accordance with pars. 5, 6, 51, 52, &c., of Book of Instructions for 1889

Upon examination we find the following objective conditions: Pulse rate; 72; respiration, 18; temperature, N; height, 5 feet 6 inches; weight, 161 pounds; age, 58 years. General physical condition is good. Scar of entrance of gun shot wound on the right side, 3 1/2 inches to right of spinal column, just over the crest of ilium. Scar is oval, one inch long, slightly depressed, superficial. Ball passed upward and forward, emerging on the anterior and lateral aspect of body, just beneath cartilage of tenth rib and eight inches from point of entrance. Scar of exit is oval, 1 1/4 inches long and is superficial. Complains of pain in the body when stooping or lifting. Gun shot wound of right foot. Scar of entrance on dorsal aspect of foot over the fourth metatarsal bone, 1 1/2 inches long, adherent and sensitive. Ball passed through the foot, fracturing the fourth metatarsal bone, and emerging near the outer border of the foot, just back of fifth metatarso-phalangeal joint. Borders of scar of exit are not defined and it is covered with hard, horny skin. Claims that there was injury to tendons and that motions of toes are stiff and painful. Complains of pain on motion in the shoulders. The pain in back is the result of gun shot wound. May suffer with Rheumatism as claimed but there is no evidence. Heart and Lungs are normal. Left inguinal hernia, indirect, complete. Tumor is four inches long by 2 1/2 in diameter. Reducible and can be retained. Ring is patulous. No other disability.

Rate for EACH cause of disability.

He is, in our opinion, entitled to a rating for the disability caused by G.S.W. Right side 4/18 8/18 for that caused by G.S.W. Left Foot, and Left ing. Hernia specific for that caused by
