ALLEGES DISABILITY FROM

l.s.w. right foot and right side passing through the body, received in action at Fort Gilman, Va. Sept 29, 1864.

A.G. reports him from organization to Aug 31, 1864 "Present for duty." From Aug 31, 1864 to Feby 28, 1865 "Absent Sick." From Feby 28, 1865, to Aug 31, 1865 "Absent wounded since Sept 29, 1864. From Aug 31, 1865 to Aug 31, 1866. Present for duty. He was mustered out with Co. Oct 13, 1866, with remark, "Absent wounded from Sept 29, 1864 to Sept 15, 1865.

S.G. reports the soldier admitted to Hospital Oct 1, 1864, from the field for treatment for l.s. fracture 4th metatarsal bone at foot and l.s.w. perforating abdomen, wounded at Deep Bottom, Sept 29, 1864, and was transferred Oct 17, 1864. No further information.

It appears from the official records that the
