

B DECLARATION FOR THE INCREASE OF AN INVALID PENSION. **B**

On this 6th day of August, A. D. one thousand eight hundred and seventy-
Three, personally appeared before me Deputy Clerk of the Superior Court of Baltimore City
the same being a court of record within and for the County and State aforesaid, Basil Kell
aged 40 years, a resident of St. Leonard
County of Calvert State of Maryland, who, being duly sworn
according to law, declares that he is a pensioner of the United States, duly enrolled at the Baltimore
Md Pension Agency at the rate of Two dollars per month, by
reason of disability incurred in the Military service of the United States while (1) While a
member in Co. G, 7th U.S. Artillery,
that his present physical condition is such that he believes himself entitled to receive an increased pension; and
that he herewith returns his present pension certificate.

He further declares that he is disabled in the following manner, to wit: (2) Was wounded
twice at Fort Gilmore, September 29th 1864,
First by a piece of shell through the right foot,
Second by a minnie ball through right hip and side also
has Genua caused by cartridge box belt around
his waist and the weight of the cartridge box suspended by it,
at Jacksonville Fla. in the summer of 1864 for which the Surgeon of the Hospital at Florida expressed
his opinion as to his disability. R. E. Ward, M.D., W. Fayette, M.D. his true and lawful attorney

to prosecute his claim; that his residence is No. , in street, of
St. Leonard County of Calvert, and State of Maryland,
