 realized to me one cent before or since
 April 15, 1899.

That I have not remarried since the
 death of my said husband Basil Kell.
 That I have not sold or disposed of any prop-
 erty since April 15 1899, not having been possessed
 of any property, except the valueless dower
 right above spoken of.
