Personally appeared before me Genl John R Kenly, to me well known who deposes and says that he was on or about the 23^d day of May ^{at} Colonel commanding the first regiment Maryland volunteers and was present with his regiment at an engagement with the Rebel forces near Front Royal Va that Fred C Parr of Baltimore city was at that time 1st Lieutenant and Adjutant of the same regiment and he, Parr, was also present at the engagement before mentioned. that he said Parr was severely wounded at that engagement receiving several Sabre cuts, contusions & John R Kenly late 1st Major Genl U.S. Vol 5th Regt and subscribed before me this 8th day of June 1881.
