It is hereby certified
that in conformity with the laws
of the United States, *John P. Overman*, who
was private, Co. G, 4th Regiment United
States Colored Infantry, is entitled
to a pension at the rate of *Five Dollars*
per month, to commence on the *thirtieth*
day of *July*, one thousand eight hundred and ninety-
one, the pension being for *four* months
and of *left thigh, loss of right*
of left eye, and amputation of
right leg.
