Hopewell Warner shall proceed to act as such Committee, he shall give bond to the State of Maryland, with sureties to be approved by this Court, or the Clerk thereof, in the penalty of One Thousand Dollars (\$1,000.00) for the faithful discharge of his duties as such Committee.
