

PROOF OF INCURRENCE OF DISABILITY.

NOTE.—This affidavit must be executed by a Commissioned Officer, or First Sergeant, of claimant's company, if possible; but if not possible to secure such evidence, then one of the soldier's late comrades should testify.

State of Maryland, County of Baltimore, ss:

Personally appeared before me, a Justice of the Peace in and for the aforesaid County and State, duly authorized to administer oaths,

Joseph Turner, aged 59 years, a resident Baltimore City, in the County of Prince Georges, and State of Maryland, who, being duly sworn according to law, states that he is acquainted with Benjamin Frisby, applicant for Invalid Pension, and knows the said Benjamin to be the identical person of that name who served as a Private in Company G, 39th Regiment of Ind. Cav. Regts, and who at (Died or was discharged.)

on or about the day of , 186, by reason of

That the said Benjamin Frisby, while in the line of his duty, at or near Petersburg, in the State of Virginia, did, on or about the 3^d day of July, 1864, become disabled in the following manner, viz: While we were engaged fighting
