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Can you recollect whether the claimant contracted or suffered from any of the following named diseases while in the service:

a Pleurisy, pneumonia, Rheumatism, Diarrhoea, Hernia, Hemorrhages, scurvy, Scurvy, Pain in Breast or side or Throat

Q Now I tell you - there were so many diseases that the men had down there that I cannot tell you what this man had. Several of us were ordered to bathe in some River at Benedict. Charles Lee was - including myself - and we suffered from a cold, and I think he was in the same lot. It was right after we had enlisted and before we were examined by the doctors and before being mustered into the service. I don't know the object of so doing. Some of the commanding officers gave the order and we had to obey it.

I cannot associate this man now with any of these diseases you have named - except to say that he was sick at some time and was sent to hospital somewhere for some complaint - I don't know the details.

I understand the questions and the answers are correct.
