

first paid by an army Paymaster and money for the I received but for Capt Fair of my Co brought me my money while I was in the hospital. Then my regiment left Benedict, ~~and~~ ~~for~~ Hilton Head, S.C. I was in hospital but they took me along.

While at Hilton Head I was with and under the care of the regimental Surgeons. We remained at Hilton Head but a short time when we were ordered to Jacksonville, Fla. when we remained some time.

I was sick when I arrived at Jacksonville, Fla but got some better, and went on duty a few days. I was all the time suffering with a Cough, and diarrhea one day while on duty, as above, drilling.

I was attacked with a severe hemorrhage ^{of my lungs}. Some of the men of my company took me to the Surgeons for treatment, and he sent me to my tent. I was so bad and spat up such offensive matter none of the my comrades would stay with me.

After this I suffered with Scurvy which made my teeth loose, and affected my gums badly.

While in Benedict, and in the hospital at that place I contracted Mumps which affected my throat. Can't say that my testis were affected by mumps. but while in Jacksonville, Fla I was troubled with a swelling of my left testicle which would get as large as my fist.

I was treated in the General Hospital Benedict Md from about Dec 1. 1863 until we went to Hilton Head S.C. While at Hilton Head S.C. I was
