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from Jan'y 1864 to muster out, he was on duty at intervals for a short time. but really was unable for duty.

He was, most of the time, doing duty with the Surgeons.

Most of the time (6 mos) while we were at Jacksonville, Fla. claimant was with the Surgeons.

Claimant was with the Co, ~~some~~, while we were in front of Petersburg in 1864.

Claimant did more duty while in Texas than any where else, but that duty was light duty.

Claimant at Benedict Md. Jacksonville Fla. in front of Petersburg Va. and while we were in Texas. Complained of a severe pain in his left side. had a bad cough, and was lame, and crippled up, at intervals. This I was told was due to rheumatism, and his gums would bleed. This I understood was serious.

For the past (3) years I have seen claimant as often as once a month. he has each time complained of, and has evidently suffered with each of the before mentioned complaints.

He has been for the past three years totally disabled. I am not related to claimant, or interested in his claim for pension.

Questions understood

Lieut — Long often excused claimant from duty. he now, I understand, lives in Philadelphia, Pa.
